Several research fellows of NSZL's staff, including László Boka, Emőke Kötél, Jolán Mann, Anikó Ágnes Patonai, Zsuzsanna Rózsafalvi and Beatrix Visy, deliver a lecture at the conference. In the wake of the first conference, which was held in September 2014 and which had a huge success (<u>"Remembering a Summer Night"</u> [1]), the central theme of this conference is also marked out by the title of a poem by Endre Ady.

Lectures of the conference focus on changes in the perception of World War I: on the historic moment, sometimes lasting for years, when the initial euphoria gave way to apathy. In arts and culture, there seemed to have been two ways out: escapism and radical opposition.
