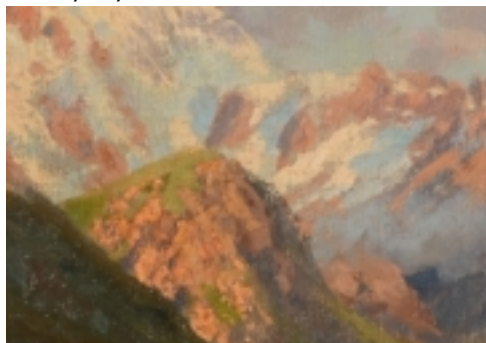


Hungarians in the Caucasus
