3 p.m.-5 p.m. Dr. Ildikó Sirató, Head of Collection of Theatre History leads a talk show with Professor Noel Witts on his topic (university lecture entitled *Questions about Shakespeare and his sonnets – or what the fuss about Shakespeare’s sonnets is*) and, based on the sonnet performance, on the sonnet poet theatre maker, the present-day UK reception of Shakespeare, previous events related to the 400th anniversary, as well as on experience with these events.
