

From the perspective of publication, book and binding history, or content, lecturers will present prints, series of prints and manuscripts kept in NSZL and other major historical libraries that played a symbolic or representative role in the history of the Reformation in Hungary and Europe.

Presented will be, for example, representative publications, the most significant psaltery and song books, preacher volumes, contemplative and prayer books, catechisms and creeds produced with the financial support of great aristocratic families (such as the Rákóczi family, Thurzó family, Pál Ráday, etc.). Most of our lecturers are researchers specializing in Early Modern Age, who work either for National Széchényi Library or for major Protestant libraries. We have also invited two colleagues from Slovakia and one from Romania who deal with ancient books and possessor research.

During the conference, a chamber exhibition presenting some of the publications discussed in the lectures will be open to visitors.


