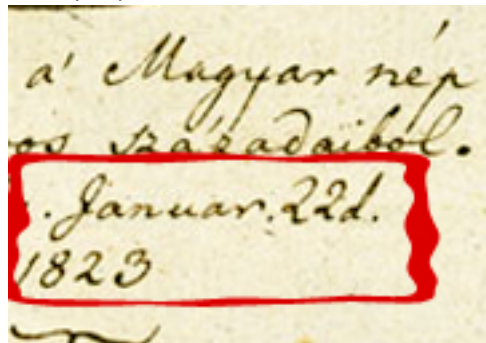


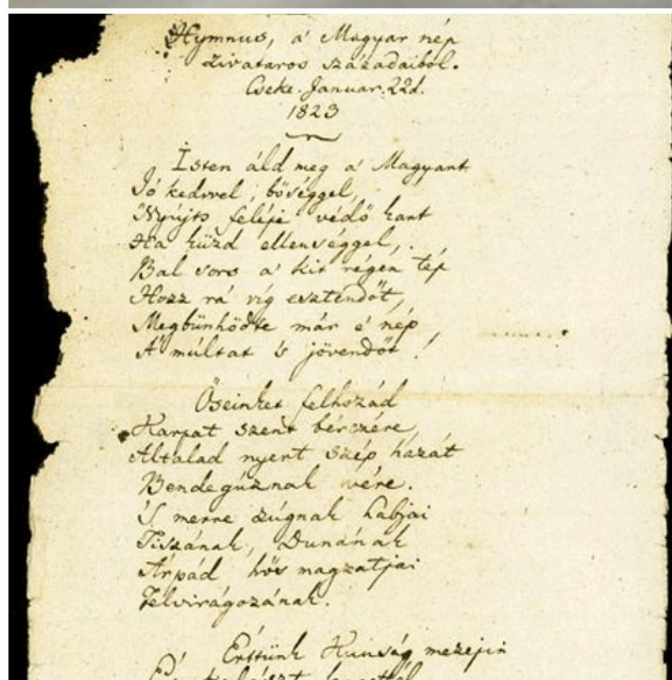
Hymn, corvinas, Júlia Szendrey - The Day of Hungarian Culture
