

An exact replica of the Perczel Globe can be seen in NSZL

The original globe, made in 1862, has been kept in the Map Collection of National Széchényi Library, where it is freely accessible.

From now on, a copy of the globe with a diameter of 127.5 cm and a scale of 1:10 000 000, which was awarded first prize in 1881 at the map exhibition of the International Geographic Congress in Venice, as part of the historical-geographical material exhibited by the Hungarian National Museum, will be on display in National Széchényi Library. Three copies of the so-called Perczel Globe were made.

One copy was placed in National Széchényi Library, one at Eötvös Loránd University Budapest, and
