rooms of the Eiffel Műhelyház. Trends in HR and communication were in focus in front of more than 900 visitors.

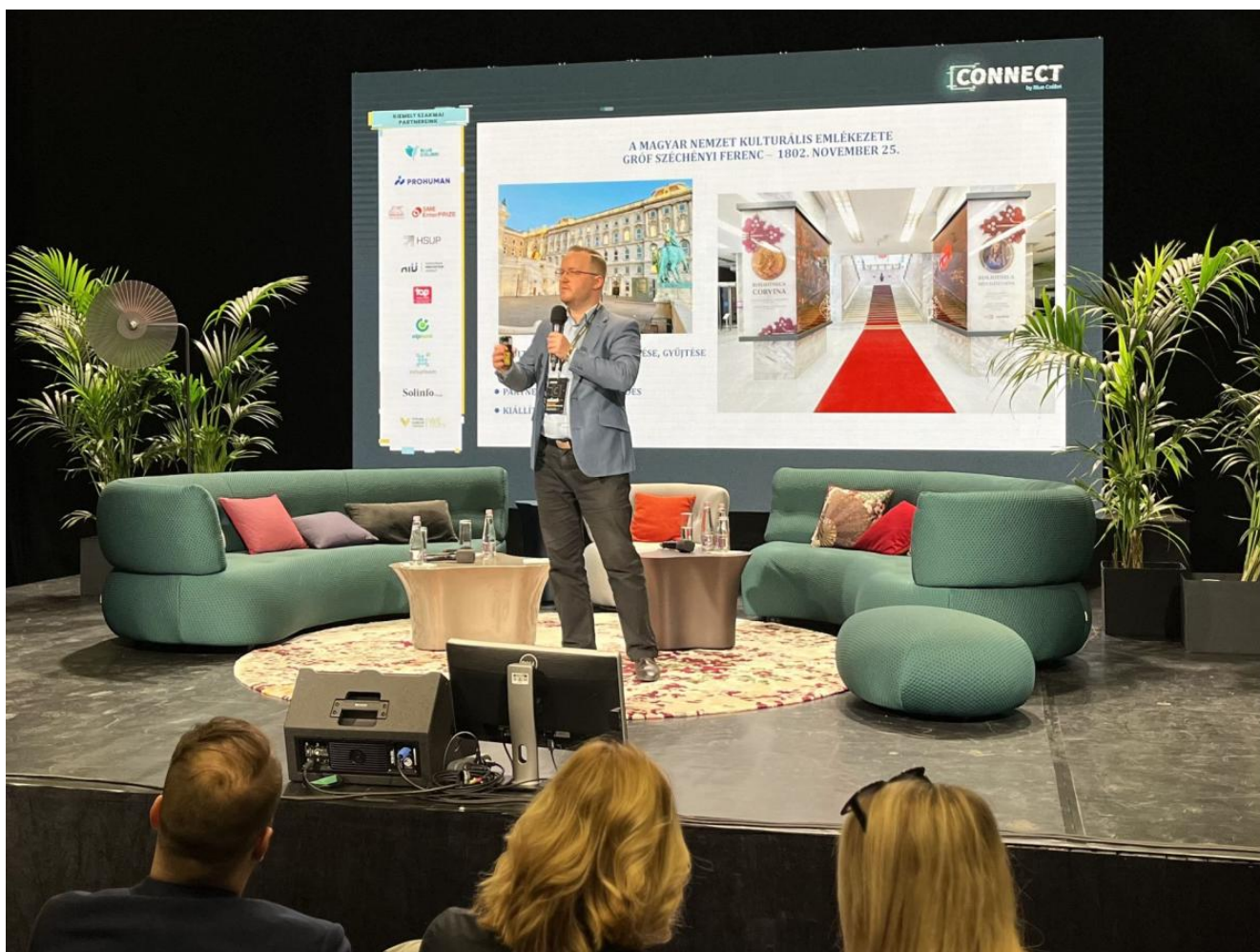
